- (1) At 40th day of blockade, Arif (25) a Shibir activist was shot dead by police (Prothom Alo 15.2.15)
- (2) During blockade, BNP Leader Moshiur Rahman (50) was shot dead by police at Magura, Shatkhira (Prothom Alo 16.2.15)
- (3) During blockade and hartal, Dinajpur Shibir activist Motiar Rahman (27) was shot dead by police (Prothom Alo 16.2.15)
- (4) Arif Hossain (22) Chatradal activist was injured by police shootout on 2.3.15 and died on 11.3.15 (Prothom Alo 12.3.15)
- (5) Shibir activist Mohsin Ali (30) died by truck accident while the police was chasing him (Ittefaq: 12.3.15)
- (6) Farid Ahmed (17), was shot dead by police in Gazipur during blockade (Samakal: 14.3.15)
- (7) Shibir Activist Omar Faruk was shot dead by police because of protest on the rejection of Kamaruzzaman's review petition (Sangbad 7.4.15)
- (8) Mehedi Hasan (28), Sumon Kumar Chaki (27), Shuvo three motor cycle riders fell under a bus while police hurt them by stick. Consequently they died. (Samakal 25.4.15)
- (9) Juel Fakir was chased by police and died (drowned on the pond) (Dhaka Tribune, 20.04.15)
