### Note:

1. Rashel, Awami League leader was chased by police, drowned on the pond and died (Samakal 9.2.16)
2. Ranju Pramanik, motor cycle rider was chased by police and crushed into tree and died (New Age 14.2.16)
3. 8 persons were shot by members of law enforcing agencies during Union Parishad election clashes and died. (Prothom Alo: 23.3.16). This number is included into Political Violence table.
4. 1 person was shot by members of law enforcing agencies during Union Parishad election clashes and died. (Samakal : 24.3.16). This number is included into Political Violence table.
5. 4 persons were died during Union Parishad election clashes shot by law enforcing agencies. (Prothom Alo: 1.4.16). This number is included into Political Violence table.
6. During Police operation, Azizul Islam (26) got frightened and died by heart attack, Haragacha, Rangpur. (Samakal: 17.4.16)
7. Md. Rashel (20) tried to jump and run away from RAB's Car and died, Sreepur, Gazipur (Prothom Alo: 21.4.16)
8. Emdadul Haque (52) was shot by members of law enforcing agencies during Union Parishad election clashes and died. (Samakal: 24.4.16). This number is included into Political Violence table.
9. During Union Parishad election clashes, when police started firing, Idris Mia tried to run away. He bumped into tree and died. (Samakal: 24.4.16). This number is included into Political Violence table.
10. Wahiduzzaman was chased by police, drowned on the pond and died, Savar, Dhaka (Samakal: 3.5.16)
11. 4 persons were shot by members of law enforcing agency during Union Parishad election clashes and died. (Samakal : Prothom Alo 8.5.16). This number is included into Political Violence table.
12. Wahid Miah (35) was chased by police, fell under the truck and died, Jayantapur, Sylhet. (Naya Diganta: 12.5.16)
13. Noman Jayaddar (40) was shot by members of law enforcing agency during Union Parishad election clashes and died, Rajapur, Bhola (Prothom Alo 27.5.16). This number is included into Political Violence table.
14. Javed (47) and Saddam Hossain (37) were chased by BGB and died by car accident , Kaptai, Rangamati (Samakal: 28.5.16)
15. Abu Hanif was shot by members of law enforcing agencies during Union Parishad election clashes and died, Valuka, Mymensingh (Samakal: 8.6.16). This number is included Political violence table.
16. Nazmul Islam (25) was shot by members of law enforcing agencies during Union Parishad election clashes and died, Gafargaon, Mymensingh (Prothom Alo: 11.6.16). This number is included Political violence table.
17. Nurus Safa Begum died in police custody after taking the drug yaba, Nakhchalhari, Chittagong (Samakal: 21.6.16).
18. Alamgir Hossain (19) was shot by police during Union Parishad election clashes and died, Kalihati, Tangail (Prothom Alo: 22.6.16). This number is included Political violence table.
19. Arif Hossain (35) was chased by RAB, fall down from rooftop and died, Uttara, Dhaka (Prothom Alo: 23.6.16)
20. Md. Jahangir Alam Khandkar (40), Ali Azam Hazari (45), Md. Shahjahan Mia (55) were chased by police, fell under truck and died , Sarail, B' baria (Prothom Alo: 28.6.16)
21. Solaiman was chased by police,downed on the canal and died,Kaliganj, Gazipur(Naya Diganto 27.7.16)
